

Swedish Accident Investigation Authority – report RL 2014:19

The 16 December 2014 the Swedish Accident Investigation Authority (Statens haverikommission – SHK) published the report RL 2014:19 about a serious incident involving the aircraft SE-LIS at Malmö airport. In the report there was a safety recommendation issued to the Swedish Transport Agency to examine, in consultation with EASA and the Swedish Work Environment Authority, the application of the Swedish Work Environment Authority's regulations and general advice (AFS 2005:6) on medical checks in working life and the Swedish Work Environment Authority's regulations (AFS 2005:20) on the medical examination of flight personnel in civil aviation regarding the employer's obligation to offer flight personnel within civil aviation in night work a medical examination for work environment reasons.

The Swedish Transport Agency has responded to the safety recommendation in an adequate and satisfactory manner. SHK consider that the recommendation has been taken care of.
