## Safety recommendations

## The Swedish Transport Agency is recommended to:

• Inform concerned parties about the risks of unanticipated yaw in an appropriate way. (SHK 2023:10 R1)

## The Transport Agency has taken the following action:

 Last spring the Transport Agency invited SHK to aviation safety seminar, helicopter where they delivered an interesting presentation about a few pertinent accidents and LTE. Consequently, the Transport Agency is of the opinion that the commercial operators within the helicopter industry are informed at this time. The Transport Agency proposes that the subject be returned to at an aviation safety seminar in a few years.

## Regarding future informational efforts:

• The Transport Agency would like to reach out with information to private helicopter pilots but, as they are rarely organised in the Royal Swedish Aero Club, the forum for this is unclear. A working hypothesis is that the Section for Flight Training address the subject of LTE at seminars involving helicopter flying schools.
