Corrective action in response to a recommendation (RS 2016:09 R3) pertaining to Finnlines Ship Management AB in the Swedish Accident Investigation Authority's final report RS 2016:09

Recommendation (RS 2016:09 R3):

Finnlines Ship Management AB is recommended to:

Act to develop the safety culture on board ships and in the company, especially in respect of the matters dealt with in section 2.5 and 2.7.

Corrective action:

Maintaining a strong safety culture is something we at Finnlines are continually working on. This is not something that happens by itself; rather it requires a major commitment from all the organisation's employees. Below, what has been highlighted following the accident on Finnpartner.

- All vessels have been given the Swedish Accident Investigation Authority's final report for on-board discussion in both the health and safety committees and together with the crews.
- A re-evaluation has been conducted for all workplace analyses and corrective action taken.
- In conjunction with internal audits, the risks of procedural drift, the safety culture and risk analyses have been discussed with the entire crew at meetings on board the vessels.
- The Maritime Joint Work Environment Council's "Work Environment Notebook" has been tested on board Finnpartner in order to ascertain whether it can have a positive impact on incident reporting and even the safety culture on board.
- Procedural drift, safety culture and risk analyses are separate subjects on the agenda of the senior officers' conferences in spring.
- All vessels have now been given a library from Videotel containing 50 video courses that are all in one way or another based in the safety culture on board. This is used actively as part of in-service training of on-board personnel and when inducting new employees.
- Regular coordination meetings between the vessels, CMP, Nordö Link and Finnlines Ship Management have been introduced.
