Assessment of response to safety recommendation (RL 2015:10 R1)

Dear Sir/Mme,

In a safety recommendation, the Swedish Accident Investigation Authority (SHK) has recommended the Estonian civil aviation administration *Lennuamet* to:

Tighten its supervision of the operator, AS Avies, in order to ensure that operations are conducted in accordance with applicable flight safety requirements, in particular with respect to such deficiencies as identified in section 2.5 of this report.


In its response to the safety recommendation, Lennuamet has reported that it has undertaken a comprehensive audit of the operator and that the operator reports to Lennuamet once a month.

SHK has requested further information as to the results and findings of the audit. However Lennuamet has declined to share that information with SHK on the ground that it is confidential.

In accordance with art. 18(2) of Regulation (EU) No 996/2010, SHK would like to inform you that as SHK has not had access to any information regarding the results or findings of the audit, SHK considers the response to the safety recommendation only partially adequate.

With this information the handling of the safety recommendation and the case file are closed – partially adequate safety recommendation response.
